Rules, conditions & information

The tournament is sanctioned by the council of the LTA and will be conducted under the LTA Tournament Rules and Conditions and the LTA Code of Conduct. These apply to competitors, coaches, parents and all other spectators.

NB: ENTRY FORMS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE CORRECT FEE.

1. The Rules and Code of Conduct of Lawn Tennis and the Rules and Regulations of the Lawn Tennis Association shall apply.
2. Competitors in all singles events must be members of the LTA Registered Membership Scheme.
3. Singles events will be limited to the first 64 entrants. No competitor may enter more than 2 singles and 1 doubles event.
4.
 - i. Play will commence at 9.30am on Monday 3rd August and at any time from 9.30am every day thereafter.
 - ii. **Please take note of following provisional schedule:**

 Boys will start on Monday 2nd August.
 Girls will not start before Tuesday 3rd August.
 10U, 9U & 8U events will take place on either or both Thursday 5th and Friday 6th August.
 The Doubles will not start before Wednesday 4th August.
 Optional, free-to-enter consolation/plate events will also take place.
 Check the web site <http://lta.tournamentsoftware.com> for exact times on Sunday 1st August after 4pm. If you are unsure on how to use the web site or unable to access the internet, contact the referee, Rhian Hayes, on 07709989042.
 - iii. Competitors must check the web site <http://lta.tournamentsoftware.com> to ascertain their playing time for the following day **after 7pm** each evening or, if they are unable to access the internet, contact the referee.
 - iv. Competitors must sign the attendance sheet on arrival each day.
 - v. Competitors must be available whenever required to play.
 - vi. Competitors who are absent when required to play are liable to be scratched.
5. Play will be on Artificial Clay, Hard or Artificial Grass Courts (at the Club or at a local venue)
6. Each event has a maximum age limit of 10, 12, 14, 16 or 18. There is no minimum age limit for any event, and competitors, subject to condition 3, may enter provided that they have not reached the respective age limit on 31st December 2009.
7. In all 12U, 14U, doubles and consolation events, matches will be the best of 2 tiebreak sets and a 10-point championship tiebreak at a set all. In 16U and 18U events, matches will be the best of 3 tiebreak sets. The referee reserves the right to alter these formats in the event of adverse weather conditions.
Match formats for mini tennis:
 10U – 2 short sets and a match tie-break (if 1 set all)
 9U – best of 3 match tie-breaks (first to 7 points)
 8U – one match tie-break (first to 10 points)
8. **Recognised sports clothing and tennis shoes must be worn. No footwear liable to cause damage to the courts shall be worn.**
9. The referee's decision is final.
10. The committee reserves the right to cancel any event for which there are fewer than 8 entries or in the event of bad weather.
11. For all events, prizes will be given for the winners and runners up.
12. The Draw will take place at Wigmore LTC on Sunday 1st August 2010.
13. The Entries Secretary at Wigmore LTC must receive entries, accompanied by the correct remittance.
14. Competitors are reminded that they may not enter any other tournament advertised to take place during the same period. The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving reason.
15. Doping Statement: "I consent to him/her participating in doping control procedures if selected, undertaken by an independent sampling officer (ISO) appointed by UK Sport."
16. Media Statement: "I consent to him/her being involved in any publicity connected with LTA Staged Tournaments, including media interviews, photographs and TV footage. Please inform the Entries Secretary if you do not wish him/her to be involved in publicity."
17. British Tennis Membership record: "I consent to the details provided on this entry form being used to update the LTA British Tennis Membership record of the person identified."
18. Data Usage Statement: "I consent to the LTA and or LTA Sanction Tournament Organisers, from my geographical area, using the details provided on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournaments via post/email or SMS".
19. "Every competitor in a singles event of an LTA Tournament must be a member of the LTA Membership Scheme/ British Tennis and have a National Rating.
20. Competitors, parents and adult friends attending the Club as spectators are, at the sole discretion of the Club Committee, Hon. Members for the duration and purposes of the Tournament.
21. Insurance – Wigmore Lawn Tennis Club can not accept responsibility for any injury or loss of property during the tournament, whatever the cause.

The attention of Competitors is drawn to Regulation II for the Management of Lawn Tennis Tournaments, which deals with payments of Entrance Fees and the signing of the Entry Forms. The council of the LTA have advised Tournament Committees that **ANY COMPETITOR WHO HAS NOT PAID HIS OR HER ENTRY FEES SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED ON COURT.**

LTA REGULATIONS

Any complaint connected with the Tournament must be made in writing to the Committee and delivered to the Referee of the Tournament within 48 hours of the occurrence.
